PREPARATION BEFORE AN EARTHQUAKE

"ALARM CASE"



- Documents
- Three day supply of food and water
- First aid kit and medicines you cannot do without
- Gas hurner
- VHF radio and whistle
- Warm clothes, rain gear, baby clothes and diapers
- Flashlight and spare batteries, charger
- Petty cash
- Brochure with contacts of special services and addresses of assistance

PREVENTIVE MEASURES



Have a plan in advance in the event of a building collapse and make it available to all family members.

Explain to them what to do in the event of a sudden collapse and how to administer first aid.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS



First earthquake shocks:

- 1. Turn off the gas, water, and electricity.
- 2. Stand in the opening of the load-bearing wall.
- 3. After the first shocks are over, run out onto the street and stand away from the houses in a safe place.
- 4. Dress warmly in winter.
- 5. Look around and start moving in the direction of the house according to the route.



DURING AN EARTHQUAKE

Key rule: Lie down, take cover, and hold on

Leave the room, if it takes no more than 15-20 seconds, and immediately move away from the building to an open area. Remember to bring your "alarm case".

INDOORS



Take shelter in a pre-selected, safe place. In a multi-level house, open the door to the stairs and stand in the doorway.

If there is a danger of falling pieces of plaster, lamps, glass - hide under the table. At school - get under the desks, turn away from the windows and cover your face and head with your hands.

Keep away from windows and glass partitions, keep closer to the inner solid walls of the building.

Forbidden!

- Do not create a crush or traffic jam at doors.
- Do not jump out the window from above the first floor.
- Do not jump through closed windows. If necessary, break the glass with a stool, in extreme cases, with your back.
- Do not use the elevator.

OUTDOORS



- Move to an accessible area away from buildings and power lines.
- Do not run along buildings, do not enter buildings.

IN TRANSPORT -----



- While driving, stop as quickly and in an open area. Do not get out of the vehicle until after the shocks are over.
- The bus driver should open the doors.
- Passengers in private cars and public transportation are safest to remain in their seats until the
 end of the shocks.



AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE

- Administer first aid to those in need.
- Release those trapped in easily removable debris.
- Take care of the safety of children, the sick, the elderly, calm them down.
- Do not occupy the phone without an absolute necessity.
- Turn on your radios. Follow the directions of local authorities, disaster management authorities.
- Check for damaged water mains. Repair the fault or turn off the water supply.
- Make sure the sewer system is in working order within the building and basement before using it.
- Do not use an open fire.
- Be careful when climbing downstairs.
- Stay away from visibly damaged buildings and do not enter them.

If additional medical or other special care is needed, wait for professionals!

It is possible that strong aftershocks may occur again in a few days, weeks, or even months. It is impossible to accurately predict them or new earthquakes.

However, in general, as time passes after a large earthquake, the threat of aftershocks decreases. The first few hours after an earthquake are the most dangerous, so in the first two to three hours do not enter buildings unless absolutely necessary.

Do not make up or pass on any guesses or rumors about possible next shocks. Use only official information.



HOW TO ACT IF YOU ARE TRAPPED

- Breathe deeply, remain calm, focus on what is most important, try to survive at all costs, and believe that help will come.
- If possible, give yourself first aid.
- Look in your pockets or nearby for objects that could help you give light or sound signals (e.g., a flashlight, a mirror, or metal objects that you can tap on a pipe or wall to attract attention).
- Try to adapt to the situation and look around, looking for a possible way out. If the only way out is a narrow utility access hole, squeeze through it.
